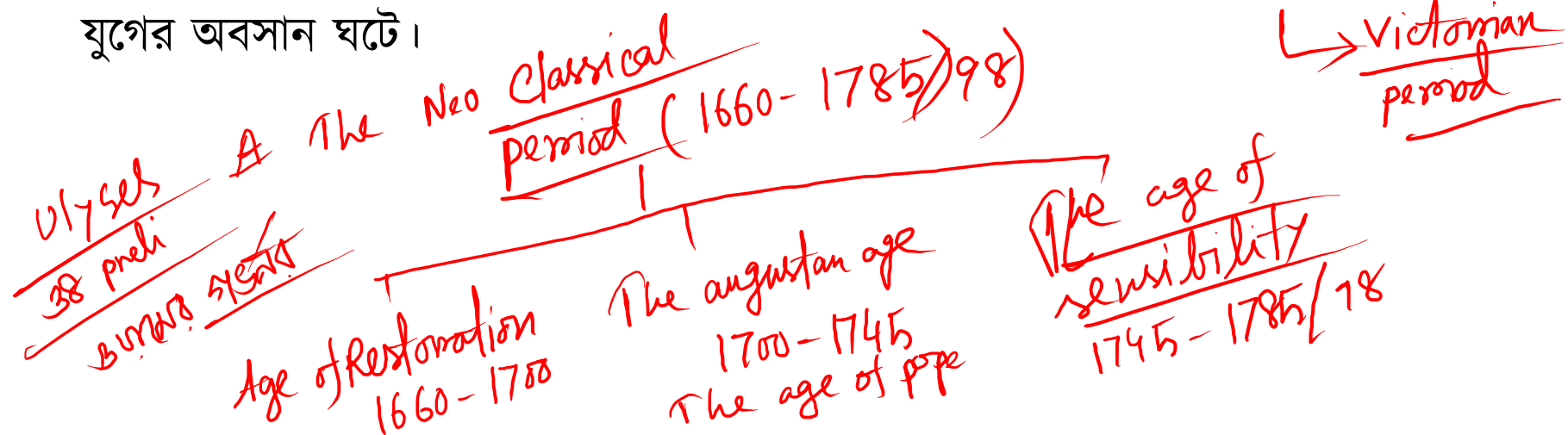

French Revolution

- T.S. Eliot এর বিখ্যাত কবিতা The Love Song of J. Alfred Prufock প্রকাশের মধ্য দিয়ে Romantic যুগের অবসান ঘটে।

- যখন তিনি নদীতে ডুবে মৃত্যুবরণ করেছিলেন, তখন শেলীর পকেটে ছিল সোফোক্লিস ও কীটসের কবিতার বই।
- তিনি ছিলেন একজন- Revolutionary poet.
- Shelley'র The West Wind কবিতায় The West Wind কে বলেন ধ্বংসকারী ও রক্ষাকারী (Destroyer & Preserver) হিসেবে।
- Shelley উচ্চশিক্ষার জন্য Oxford University-তে ভর্তি হয়েছিলেন। কিন্তু নাস্তিকতাকে সমর্থন করে The Necessity of Atheism লেখার জন্য বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় থেকে বহিস্কৃত হয়েছিলেন।
- তাঁর রচিত ২টি নাটক হলো Cenci (দি চেনসি) ও Prometheus Unbound। দুটি নাটকই tragedy (বিয়োগাত্মক)।
- Shelley'র সমসাময়িক অন্যান্যরা অনুপ্রাণিত হয়েছিলেন- French Revolution দ্বারা। কিন্তু Shelley ছিলেন ব্যতিক্রম।
- Shelley ছিলেন একজন Optimistic & Pessimistic (আশাবাদী এবং নিরাশাবাদী/নৈরাশ্যবাদী)।
- তাঁর প্রথম দীর্ঘ কবিতা- “Queen Mab”.

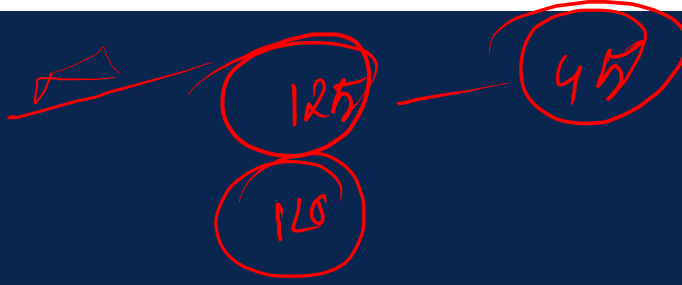
