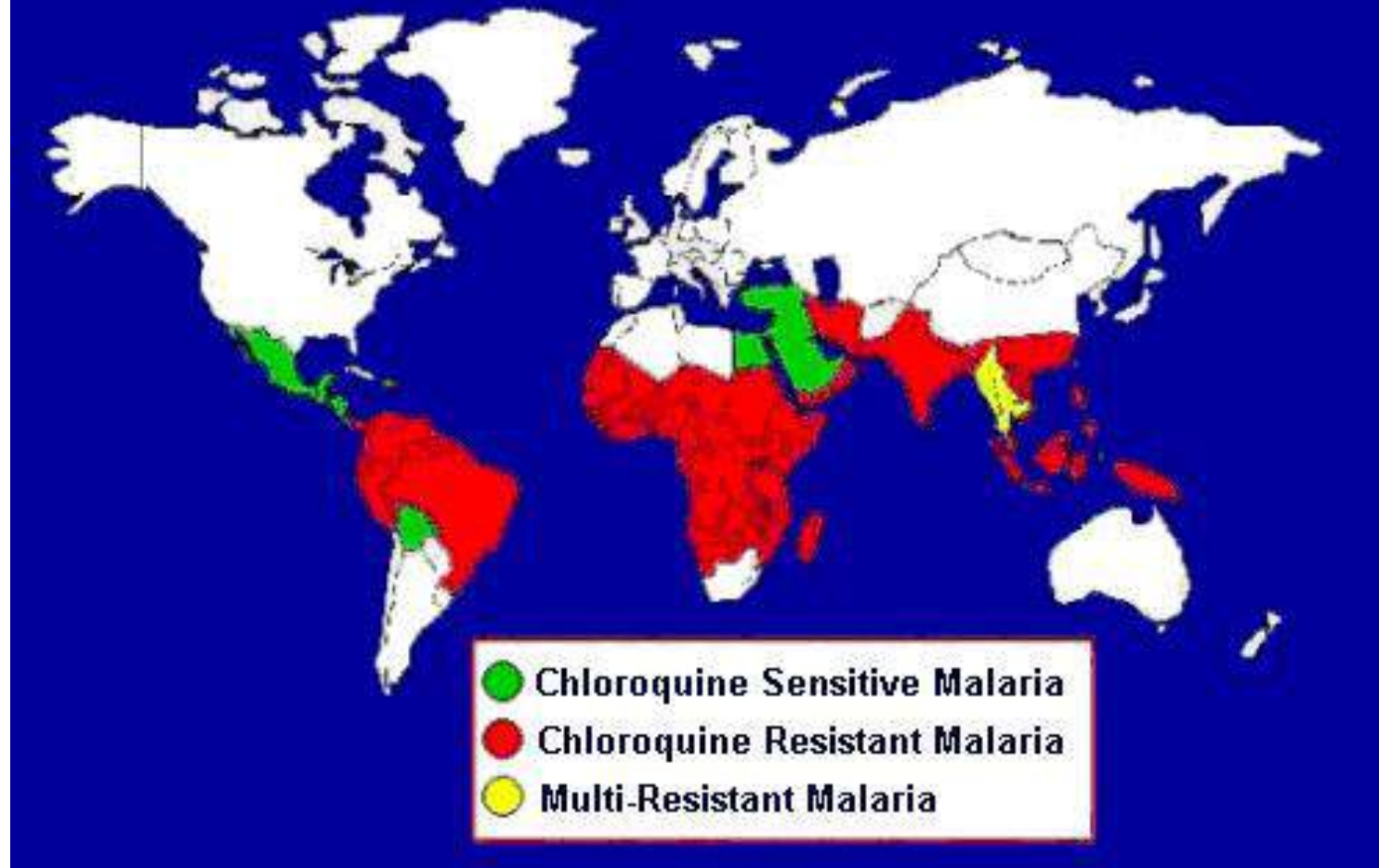

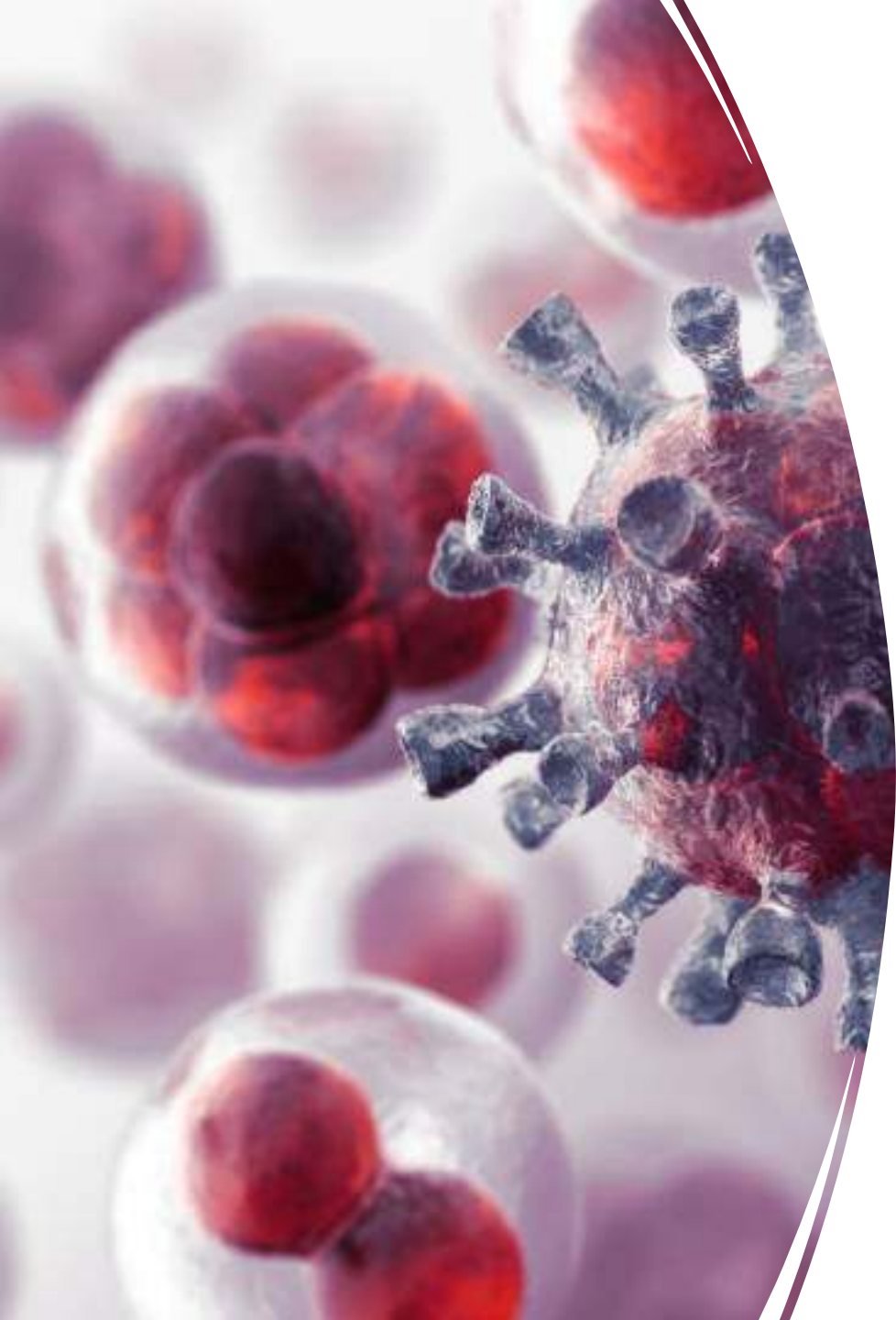
Malaria Endemic Areas

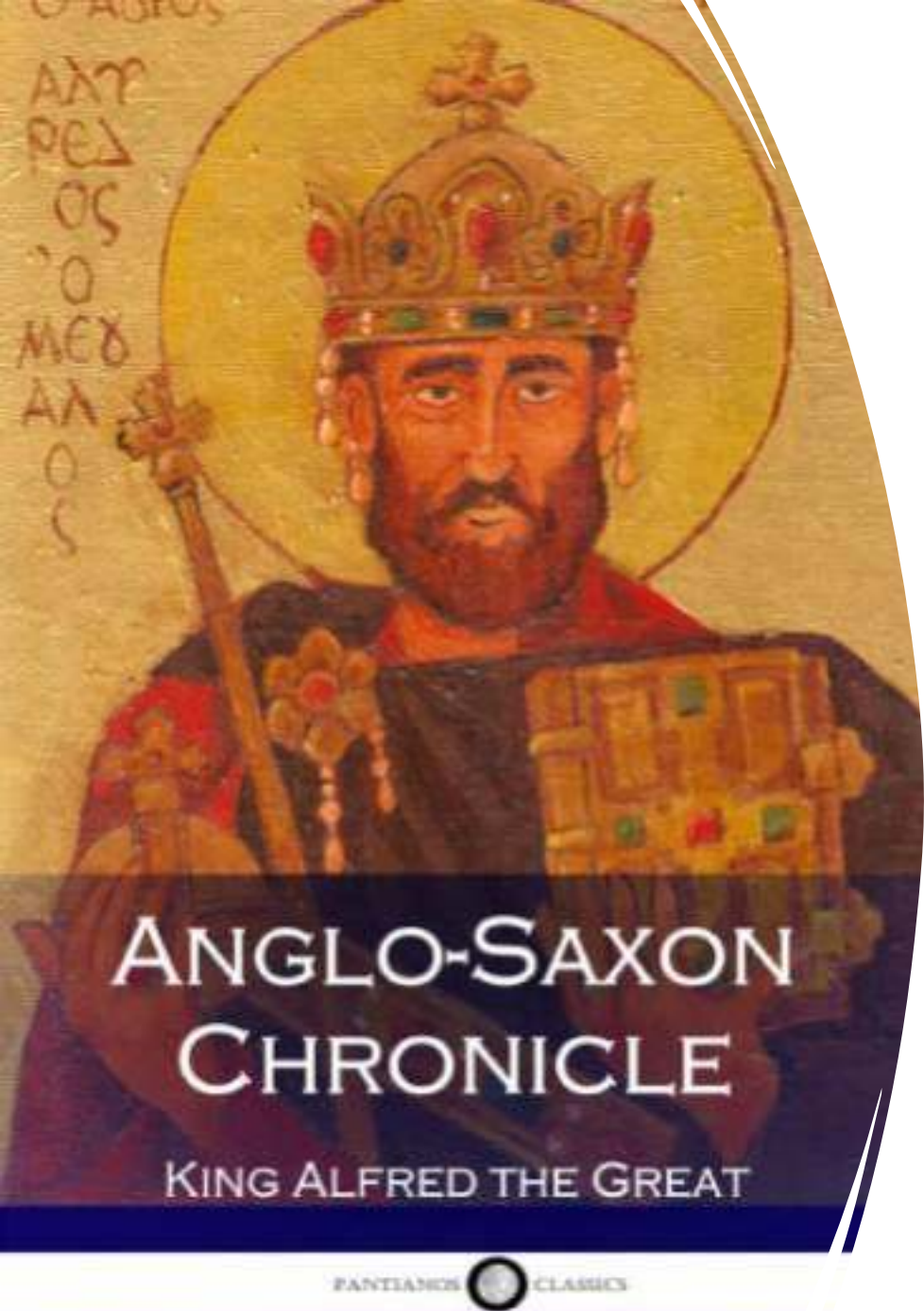

- A record of past time; history



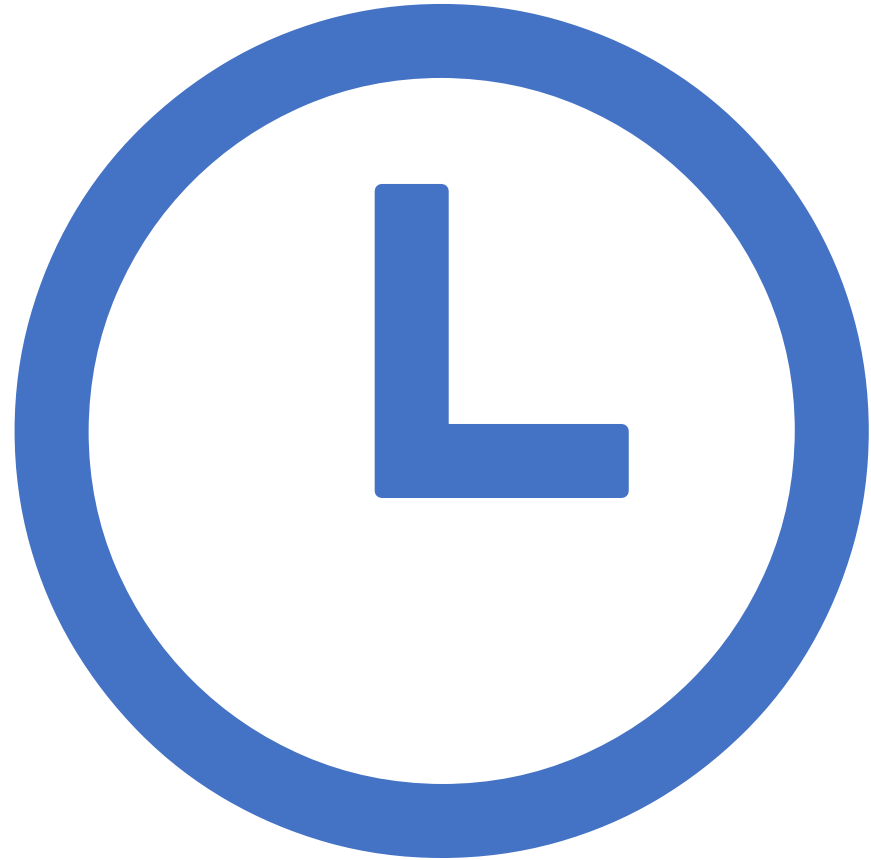
Chronomancy

Taking equal time



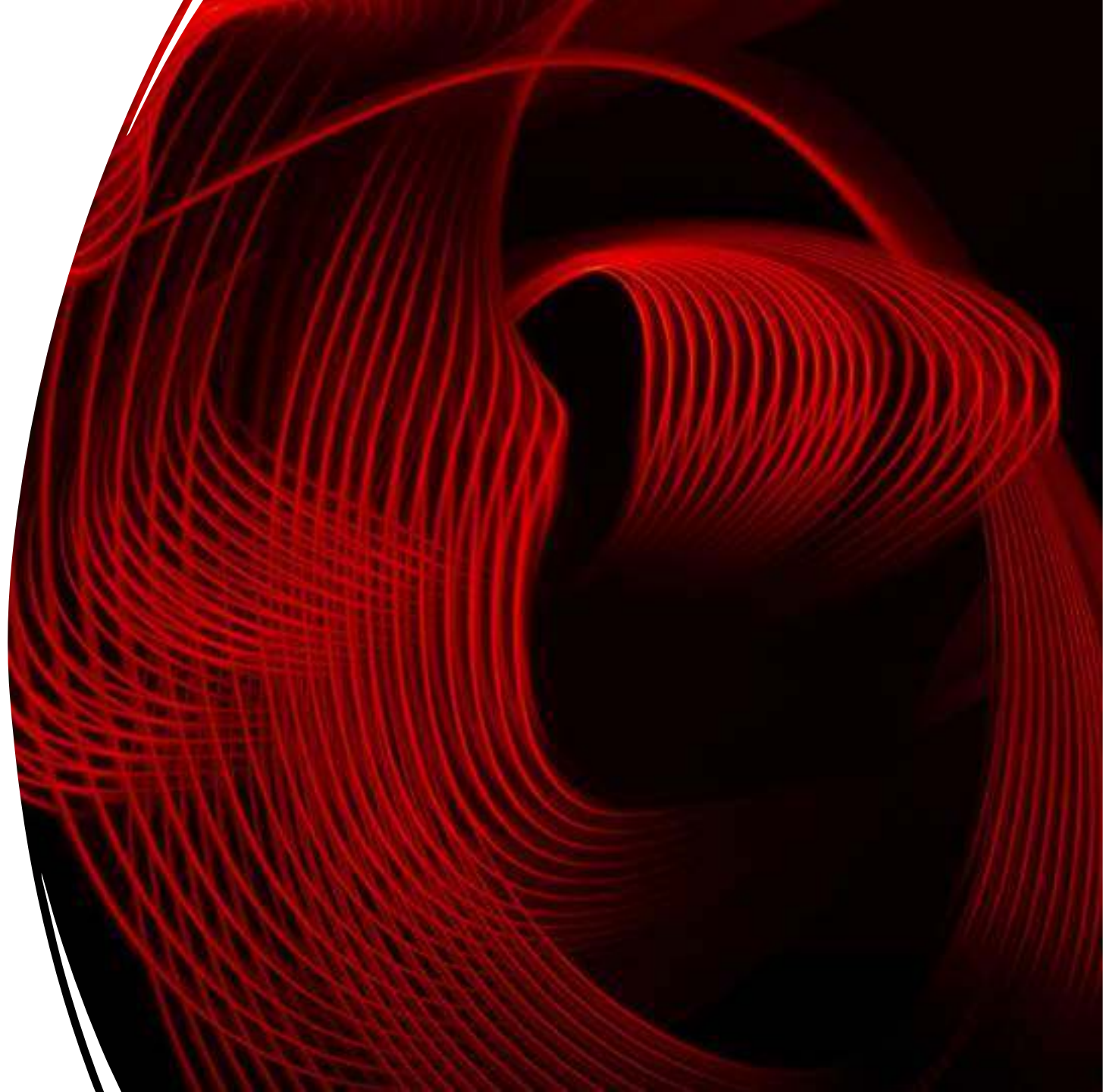

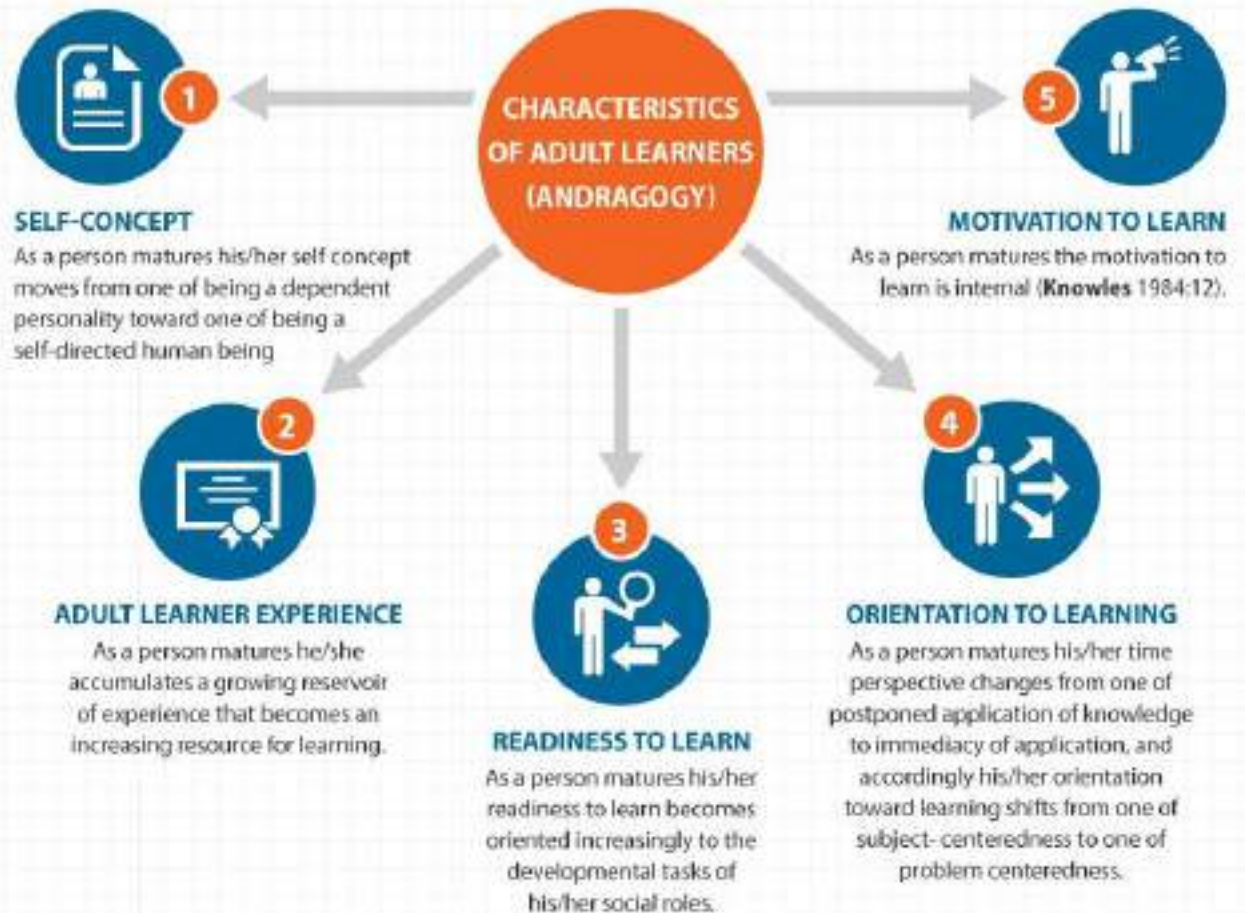

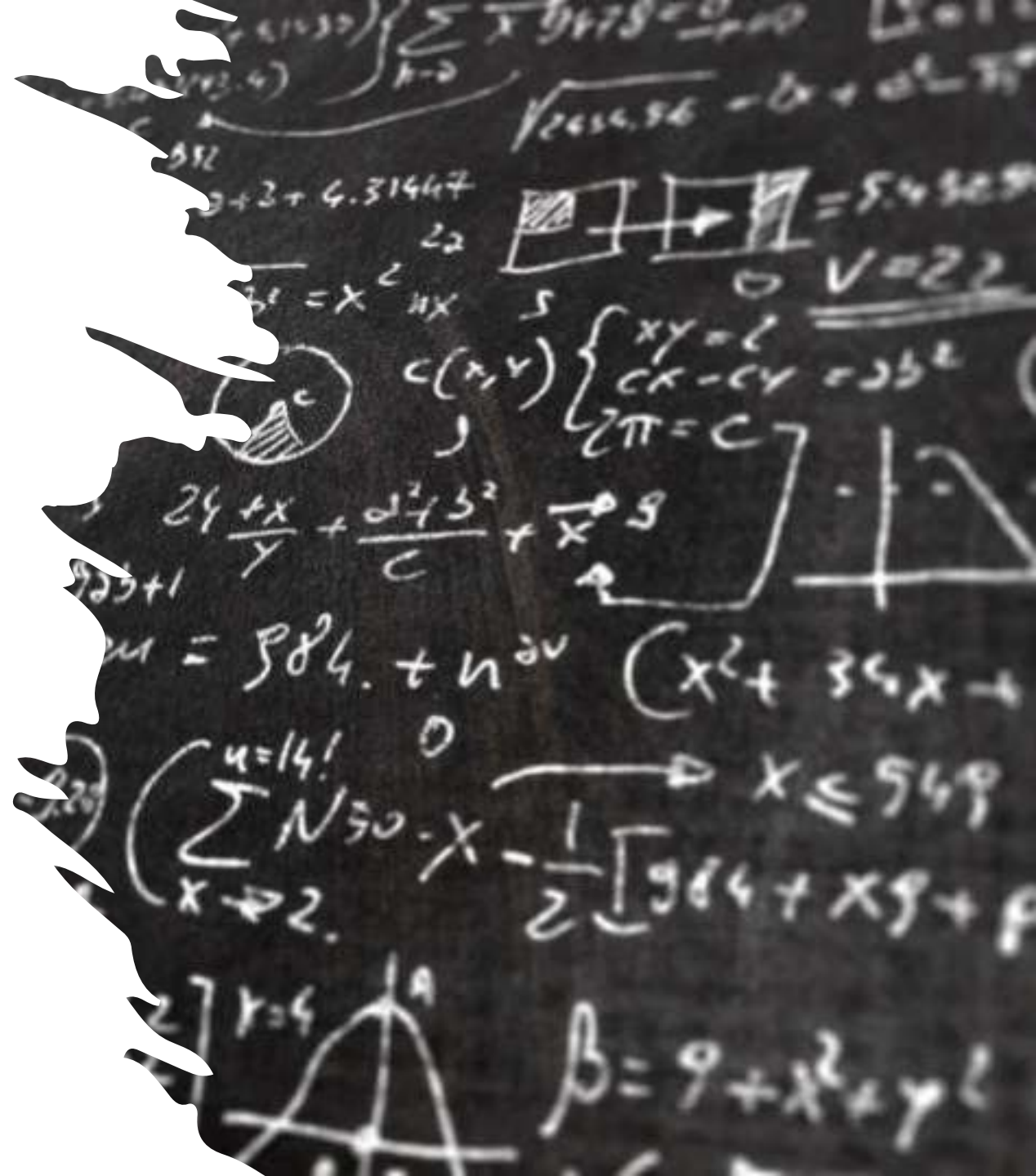

- Method of bringing forward a number of particular instances to lead to a general conclusion; argument by induction



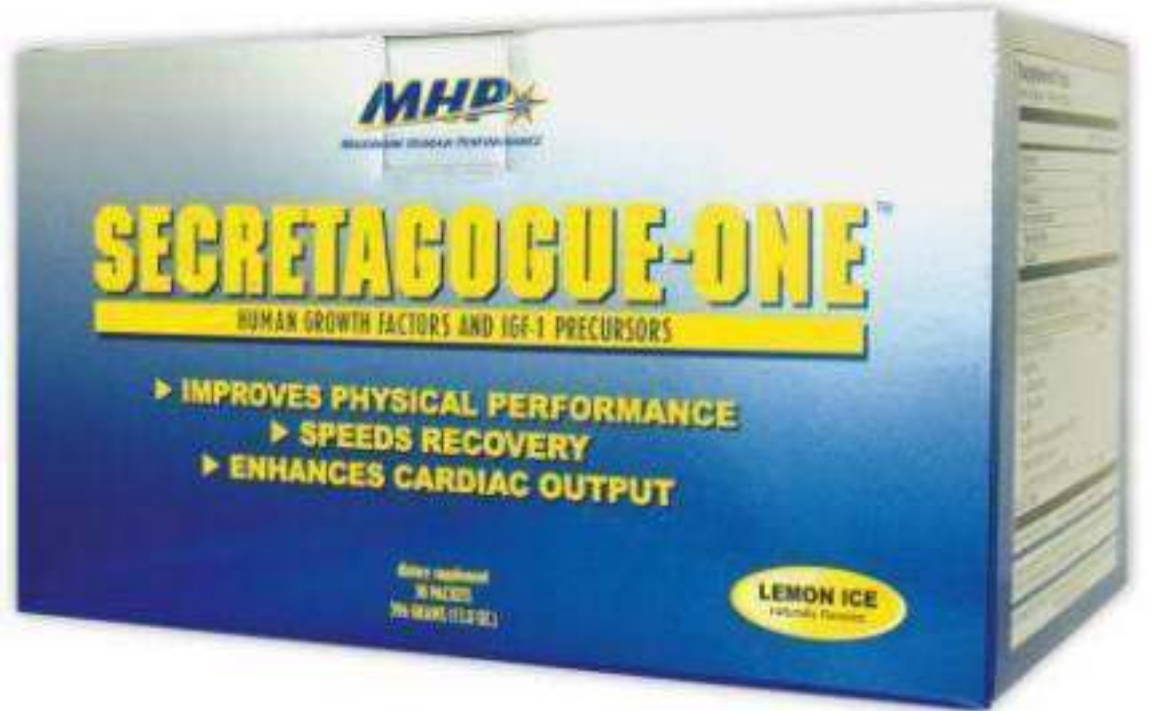
Mystagogue

Antisialagogue

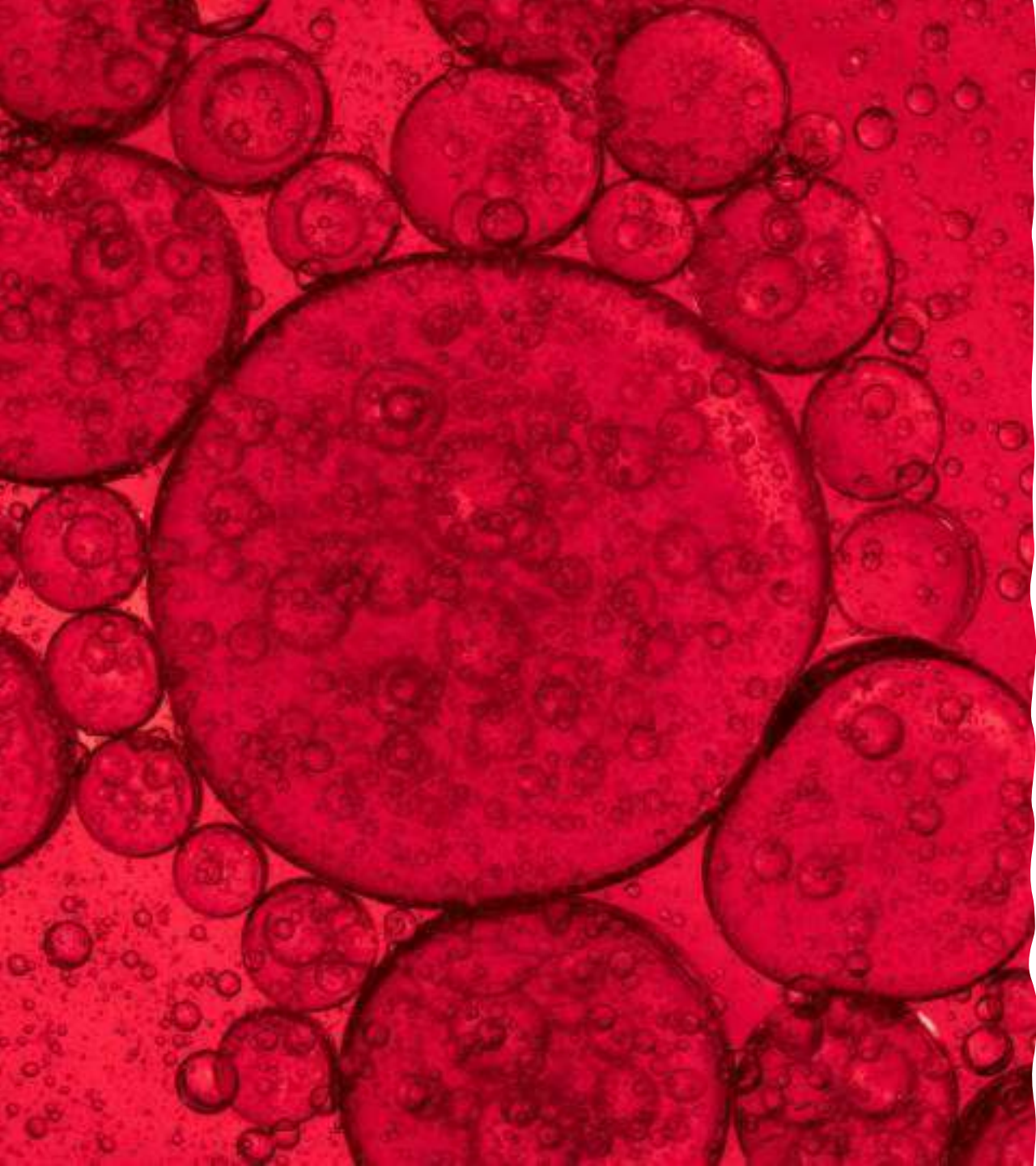
- Medicine which stops or reduces secretion of saliva
