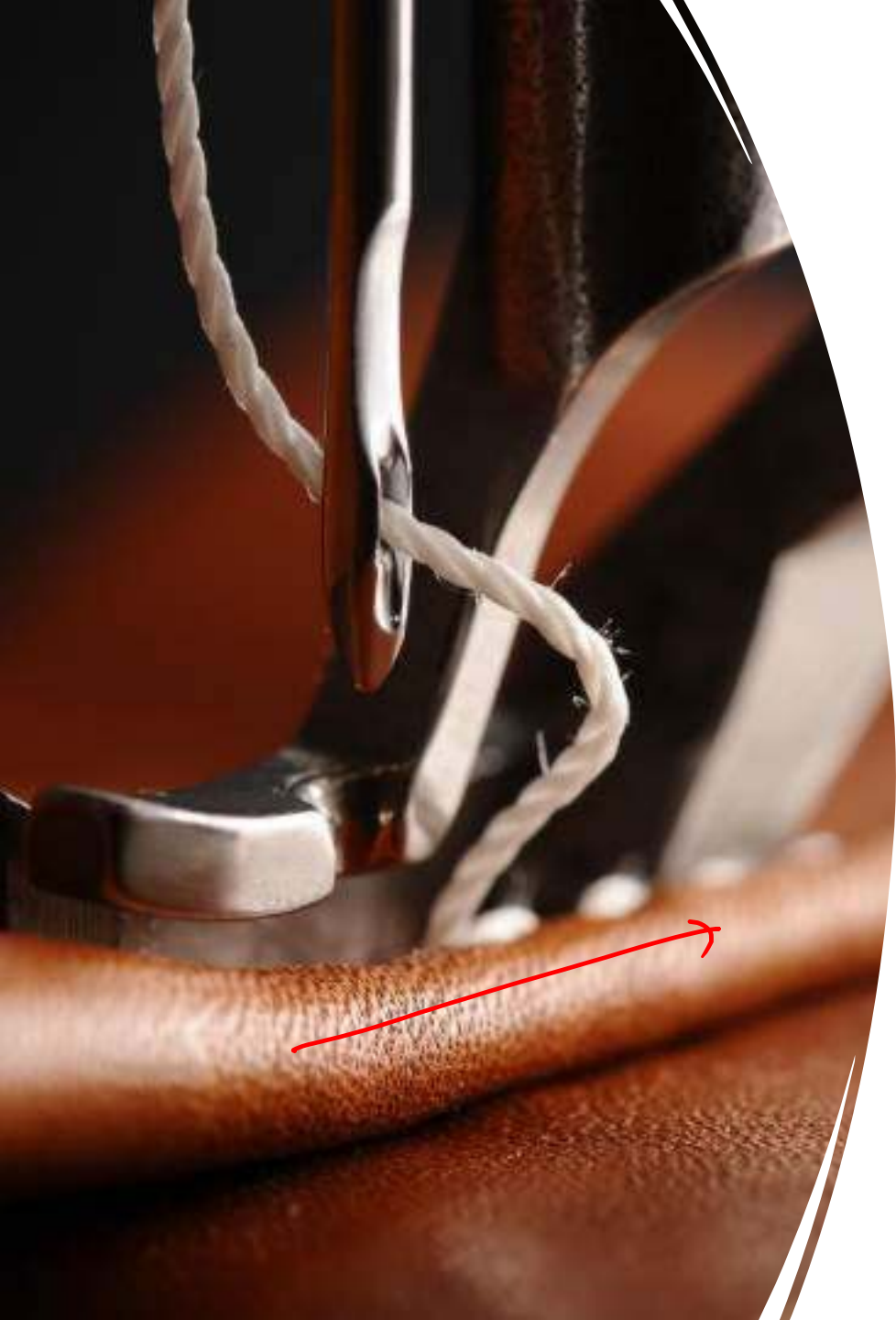

Half-circled theatre

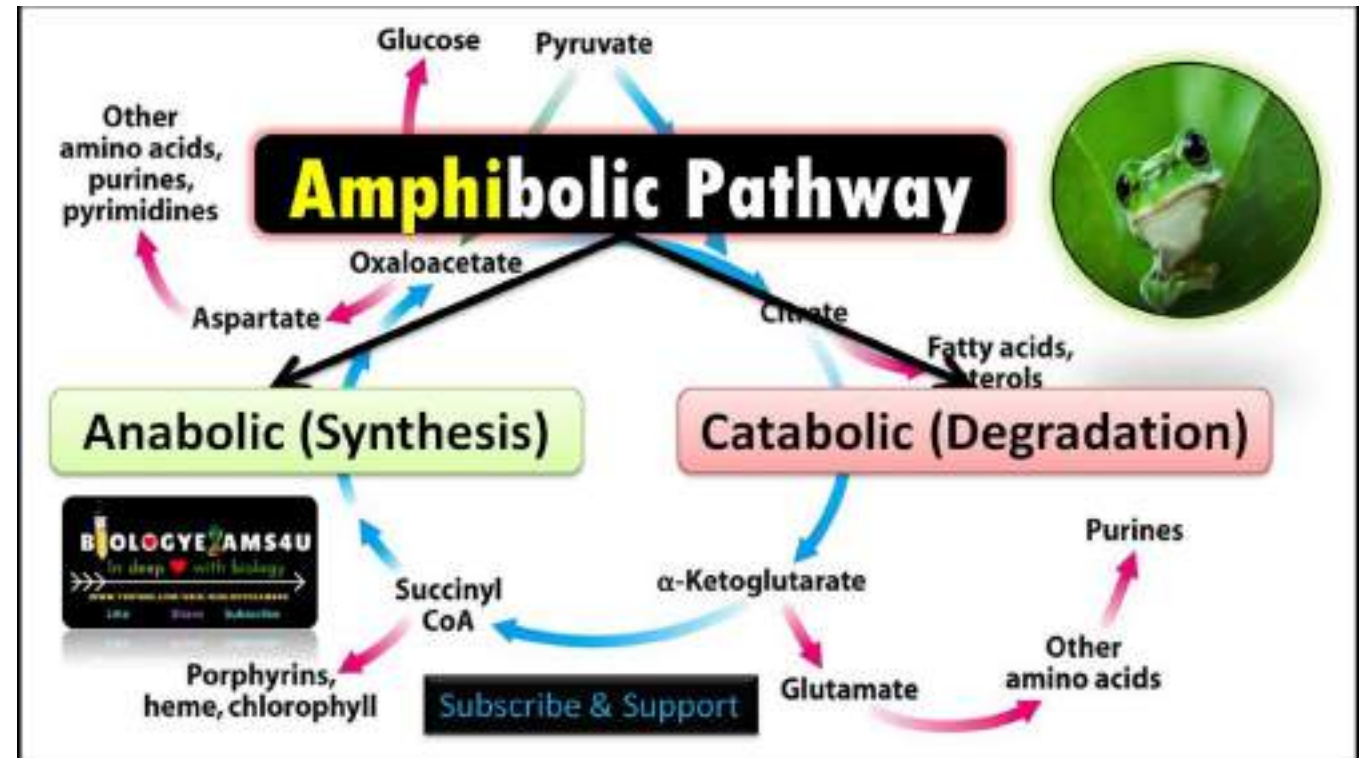


Amphora

Colloquialism vs Slang

- Colloquialism is informal, everyday language that is used by a specific geographical region
- Both colloquialism and slang are spoken forms of the language. Both use informal words and expressions. Slang is more informal than colloquial language. Slang is predominantly used by certain groups of people while colloquial language is used in everyday speech by ordinary people.
- For example, “soccer” is a colloquial term in America for “football,” a colloquial term in the UK

Pollen arrives on the stigma of the another flower on the same plant

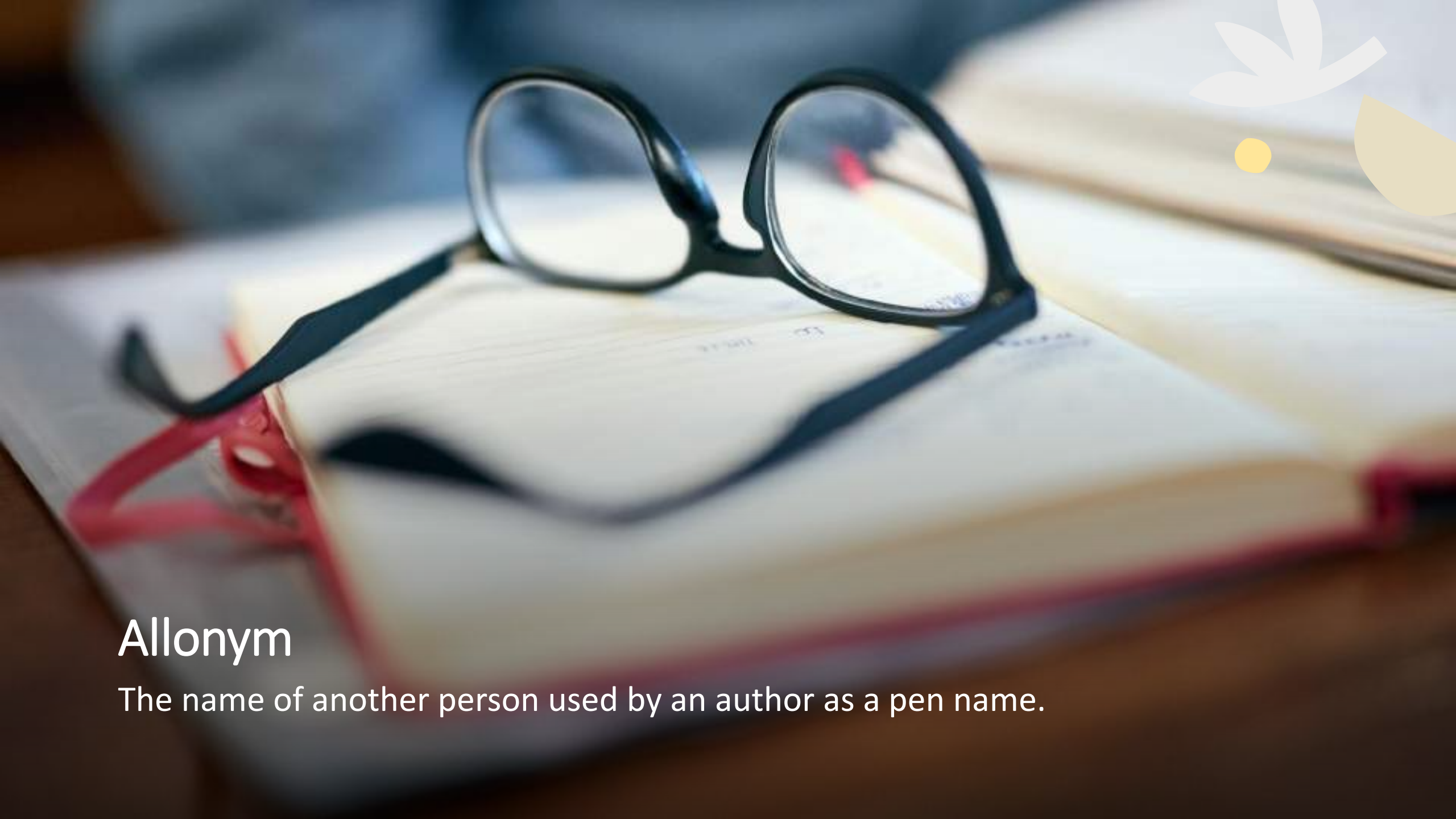
