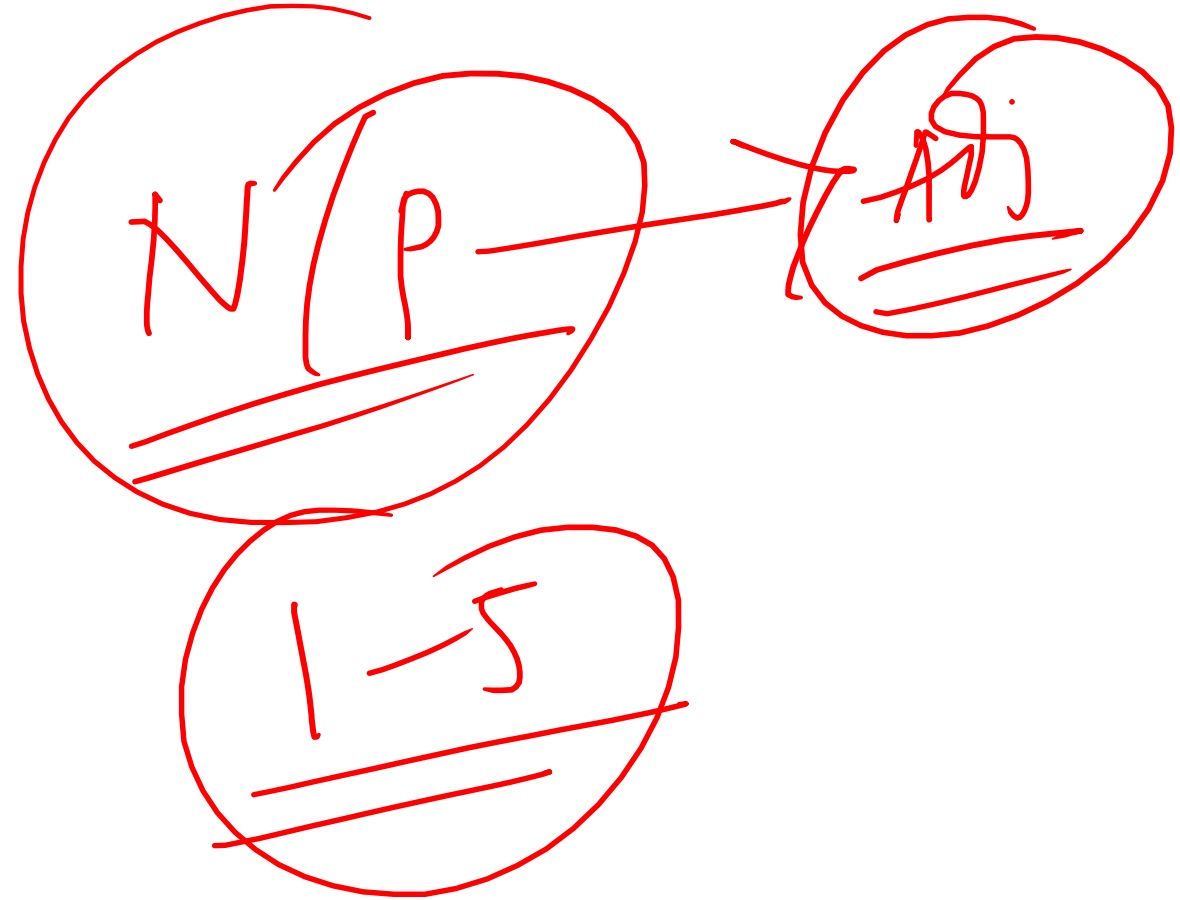

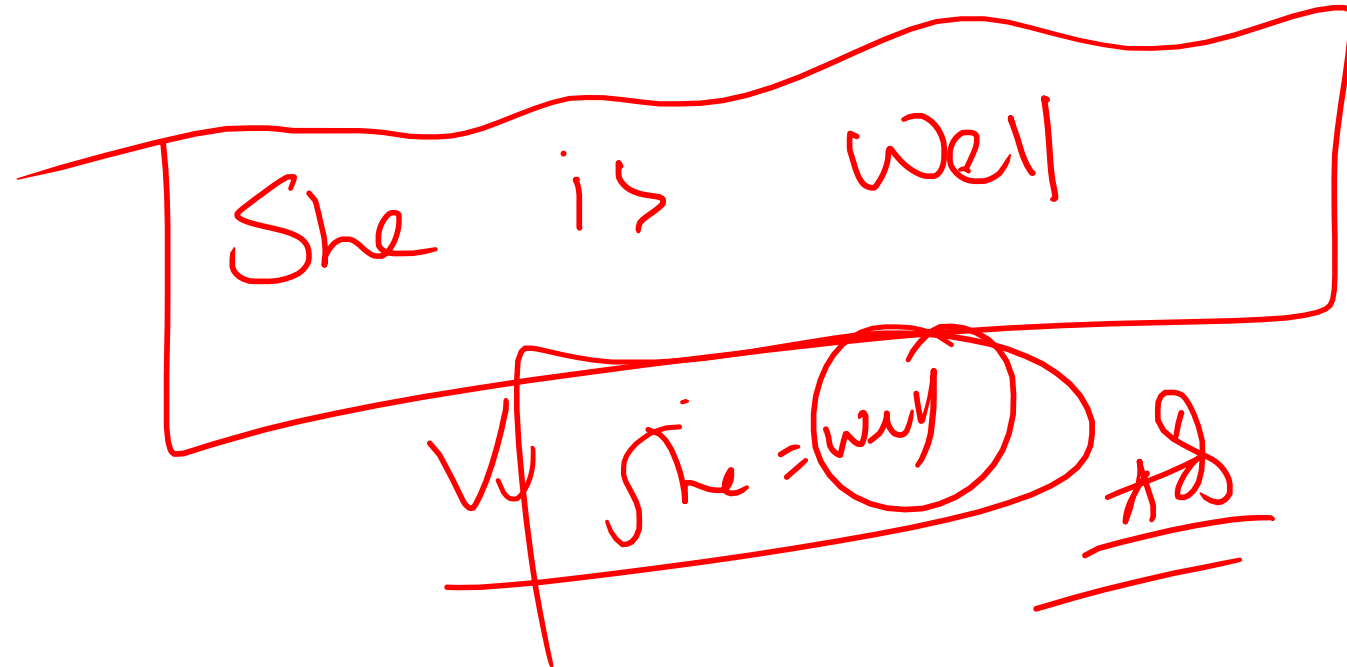

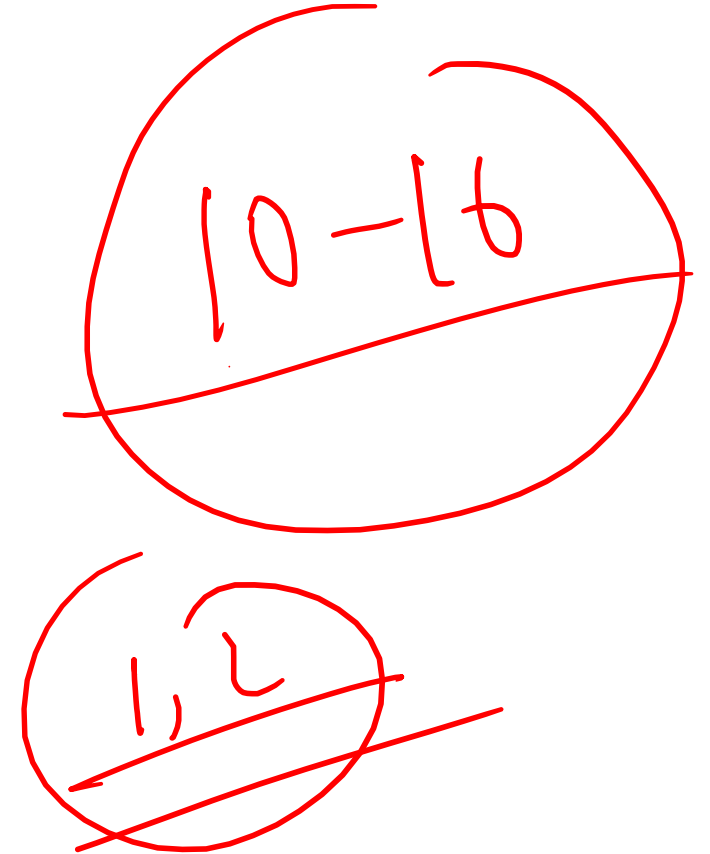

Adverb of Cause and effect

Adverbs of Assertion/Negation

Interrogative Adverb

Interrogative Adverb

- When are you starting for Khulna? (time)
- Why have you done this? (reason)
- Where does she live? (place)
- How have you solved the problem? (way)

Relative Adverb

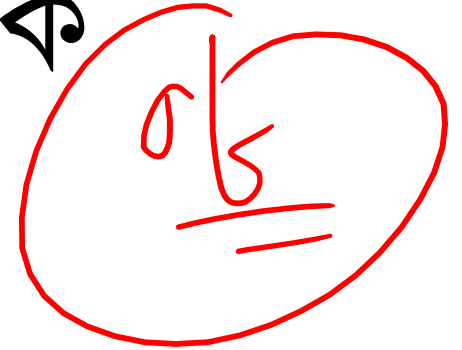


Genitive Adverb

Adverb particle

Adverb particles are words like **up, off, in, down, out** used as part of a phrasal verb.

Come **in**.

Stand **up**.

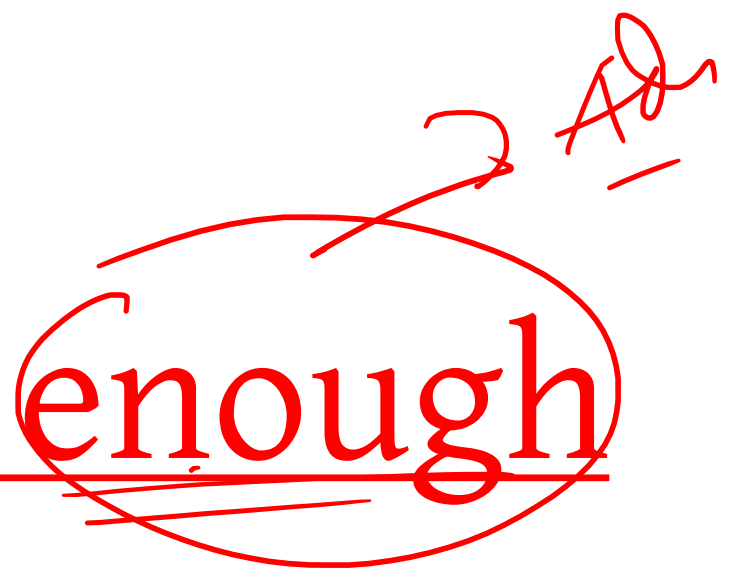

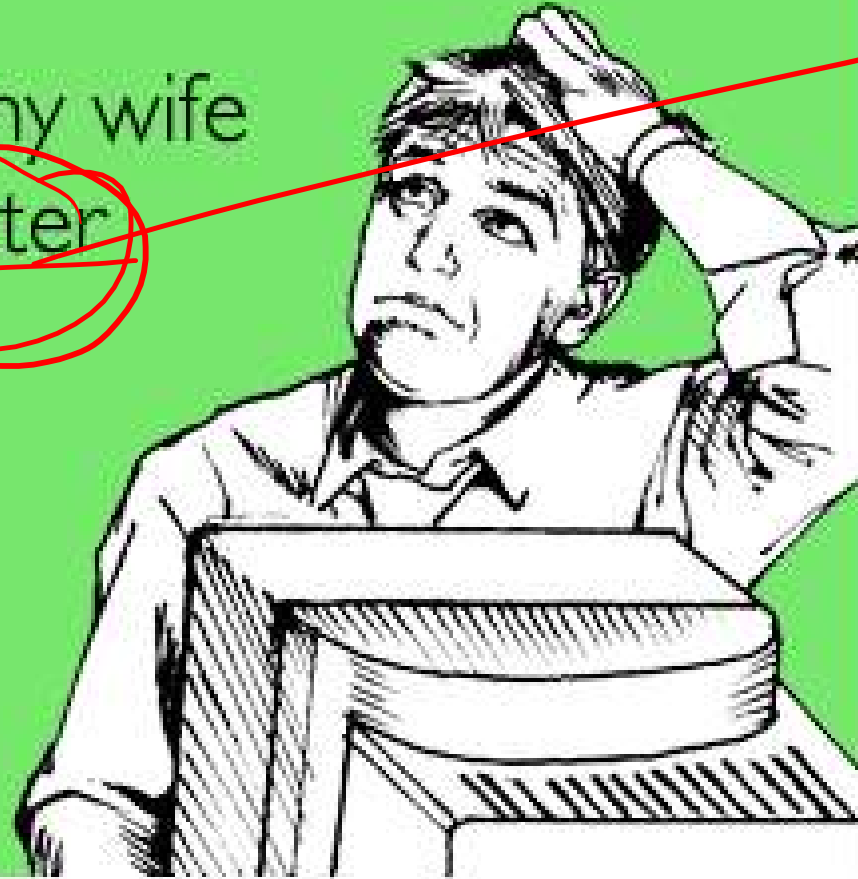
