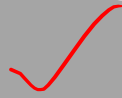

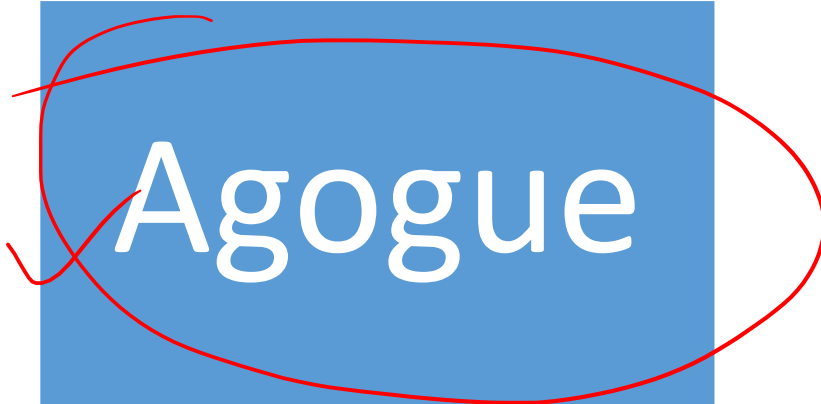

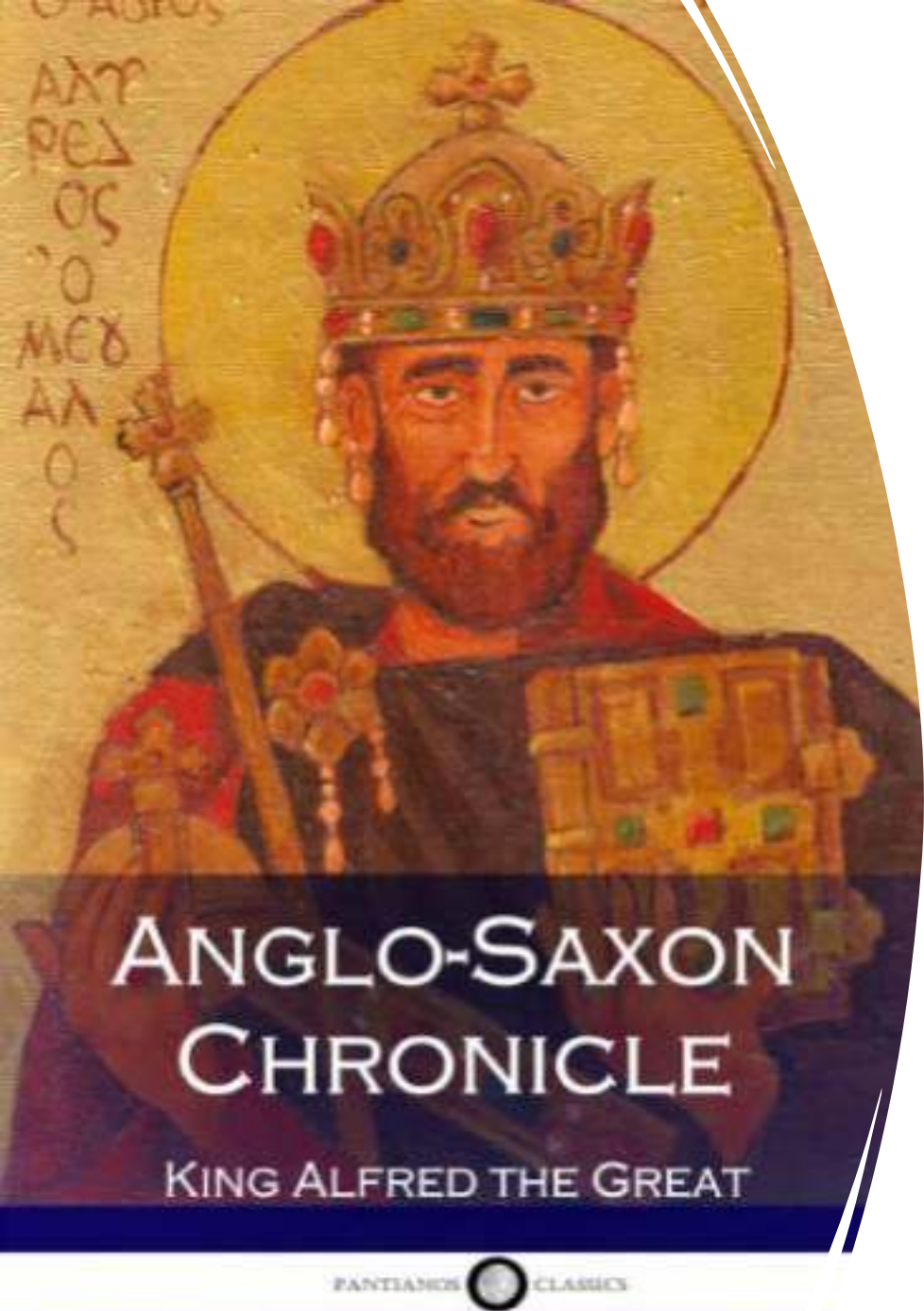

# Chronograph

---

A chronograph is a specific type of watch that combines two key functions:

- **Standard Watch**: It displays the time like a regular watch would.
- **Stopwatch**: It has the ability to measure and record elapsed time intervals.



# Time Chronomancy

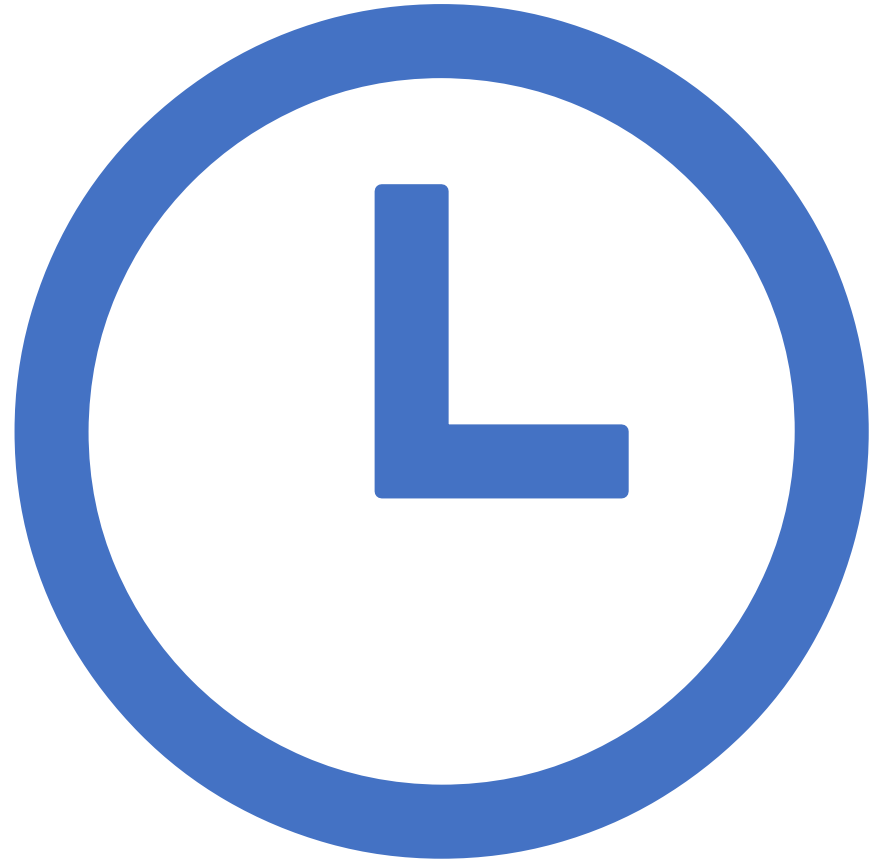
Greek "chronos" (time) and "manteia"

# Achronism
