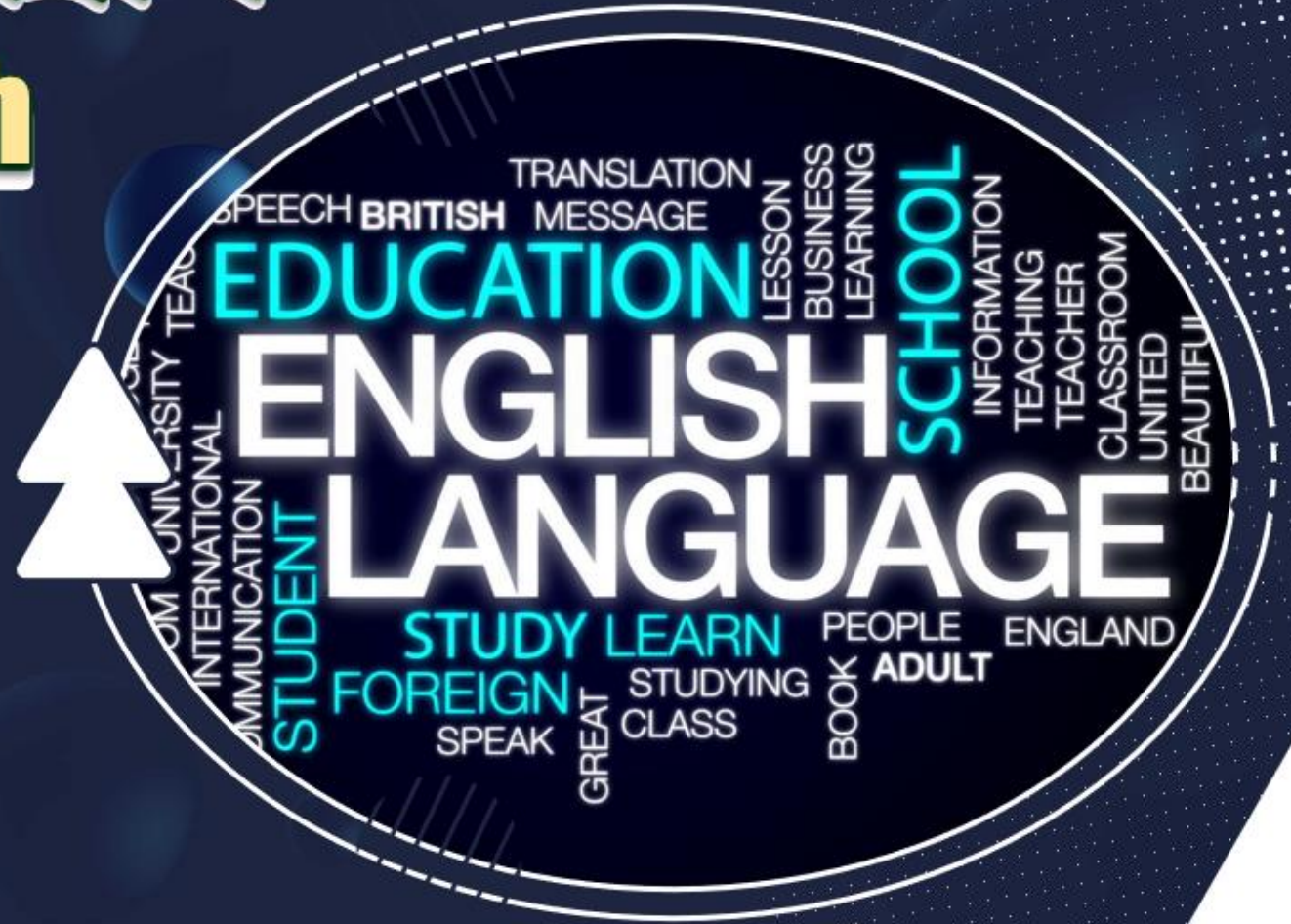

✓ **Adjective:** Adjectives সর্বদা Noun/Pronoun কে Qualify/Modify করে। অর্থাৎ Noun/pronoun এর দোষ, গুণ, অবস্থা, সংখ্যা, পরিমাণ ইত্যাদি প্রকাশ করে।

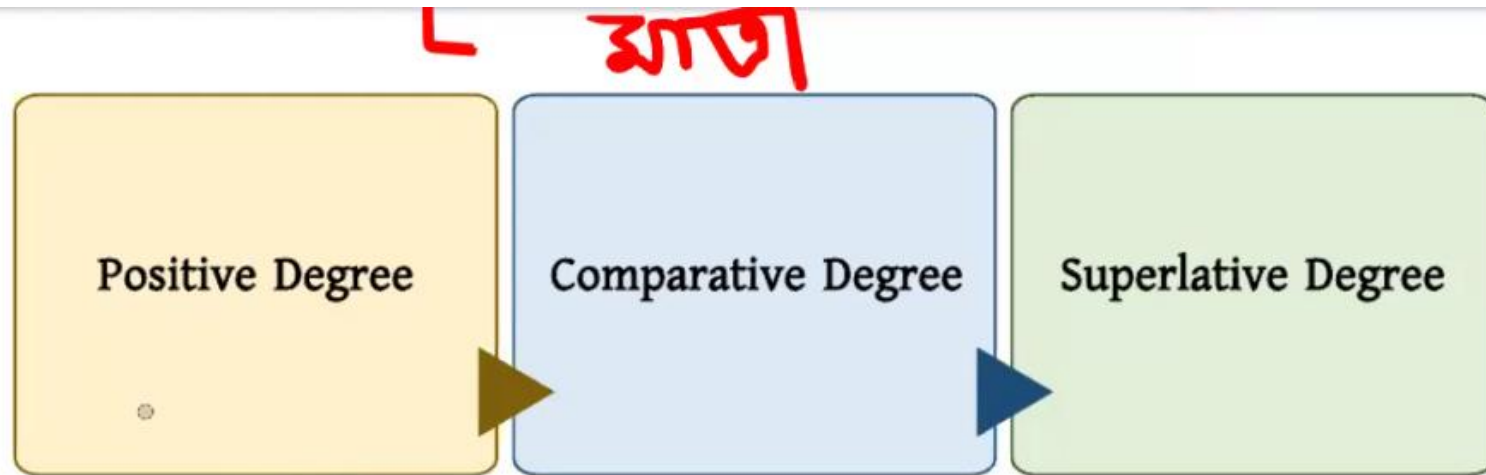

- ❖ One of এর পর যদি Superlative থাকে তাহলে উহার পর nounটি plural হয়।

He is one of the richest boys.

- ❖ Perfect, supreme, false, complete, unique, universal, extreme প্রভৃতি শব্দগুলো নিজেরাই superlative অর্থ প্রদান করে বলে এদের পূর্বে most বা অন্য কোনো qualifier বসে না। (most/very)

This is a unique case.

He is the perfect judge.

- ❖ ~~Older, elder, oldest, eldest:~~ এ শব্দগুলোর অর্থ কাছাকাছি হলেও ব্যবহারগত পার্থক্য রয়েছে। একই পরিবারভুক্ত ব্যক্তিবর্গের ক্ষেত্রে elder/eldest ব্যবহার করা হয় এবং older/oldest ব্যবহার করা হয় অন্যান্য ক্ষেত্রে।

❑ Superlative into Comparative:

Rule: Sub+ verb+ superlative এর comparative form + than any other +

Superlative: He is the best player in the team.
Comparative: He is better than any other player

Rule: One of the যুক্ত superlative degree কে comparative degree তে রূপান্তরিত করার নিয়মঃ
Sub + verb + superlative comparative form + than most other +

Superlative: Kibria is one of the best players of the team.
Comparative: Kibria is one of the best players of the team.

❑ Positive into Comparative:

Rule: "No other":

the last subject of the sentence + verb + comparative form of the positive degree + than any other + no other এর পর থেকে verb এর পূর্ব পর্যন্ত;

Positive: No other player in the team is as
Comparative:

Rule: He is better than any other good as him
As.....as যুক্ত positive Degree কে Comparative Degree তে রূপান্তর করার নিয়মঃ
প্রদত্ত sentence এর শেষের subject + verb + not + positive degree এর comparative form + than + প্রদত্ত sentence এর প্রথম subject.

Positive: He is as good as Karim
