After five months of suffering and destruction under unrelenting attacks by Russian aircraft, the Syrian people **have** at last **received** some good news: an agreement announced early Friday morning in Munich between the United States and Russia to deliver desperately needed humanitarian aid to besieged Syrian cities, followed by at least a temporary cessation of hostilities.
2. As Secretary of State noted, “The real test **is** whether all parties **honor** those commitments.”
3. Given the brutality and dictatorial ambitions of Syria’s president, Bashar al-Assad, and the duplicitous behavior of his chief ally, President Vladimir Putin of Russia, that **is** a huge if.
4. But for the moment it **is** worth celebrating a step toward what could be the first sustained halt in the fighting in Syria since the civil war began in 2011.
5. The halt **will not begin** for a week — assuming it **is** not derailed — and **does not include** all the combatants, including the Islamic State.
6. Nor **was** it clear that it **includes** all of the rebel groups that have been fighting Mr. Assad, with diminishing success.
7. For this to be anything more durable than a temporary and fragile respite **will depend** on further peace talks.

In addition, some diplomats **noted** that the pause essentially **freezes** a status quo that **favours** Mr. Assad and the Russians — and that Moscow **may have been** more amenable now since the airstrikes and Mr. Assad's ground operations **have helped** Mr. Assad regain control over much of the country's populated western areas, driving opposition forces out of Aleppo.
9. Until now, Mr. Putin **has been** fully **engaged** in the destruction of Syria and its people. In the last five months, Russian aircraft and bombs **have reportedly killed** nearly 1,400 civilians, including 527 women and children, all in the service of perpetuating Mr. Assad's brutal and unyielding dictatorship.
10. Much of this carnage, Amnesty International has found, **has been** in clear violation of international law.
11. The Russians **have attacked** residential areas with cluster munitions and unguided bombs, which **are** not only banned but also difficult to target with any precision, striking at least one hospital and a mosque in Idlib.
12. Doctors Without Borders **says** 13 health facilities **have been attacked** since the start of the year; others say schools, markets and other sites with no obvious military use **have also been hit**.
