Descriptive Adjective ★	big, red, happy, beautiful, old, delicious, tall, short, smart, brave, strong, weak, fast, slow, loud, quiet, bright, dark, colorful, smooth, rough, shiny, dull, new, old, fresh, stale
Quantitative Adjectives	many, few, some, all, several, enough, more, less, little, much
Demonstrative Adjectives	this, that, these, those
Possessive Adjectives	my, your, his, her, its, our, their
Interrogative Adjectives	which, what, whose
Indefinite Adjectives	any, some, several, many, few, all, both, each, every, either, neither, enough
Comparative Adjectives	taller, faster, smarter, stronger
Superlative Adjectives	tallest, fastest, smartest, strongest
Distributive Adjectives	Each, Every, Neither, Any, Both.

● Quantitative adjectives:

Few: Few people attended the concert, so it was not crowded.

Many: Many tourists visit this city every year because of its beautiful landmarks.

Some: Some of the cookies were burnt.

All: All of the participants in the race received a medal.

None: None of the students knew the answer to the difficult question.

Several: Several students volunteered to help with the fundraiser.

Both: Both of the puppies were adopted by loving families.

Neither: Neither of the movies playing at the theater tonight appeal to me.

● Demonstrative adjectives:

This: This shirt is too small for me.

That: That restaurant has the best pizza in town.

These: These shoes are my favorite because they're comfortable and stylish.

Those: Those flowers smell wonderful.

This: This time last year, I was living in a different city.

That: That book on the shelf is a classic.

These: These cookies are delicious; you should try one.

Those: Those clouds in the sky look like they're going to bring rain.

● Possessive adjectives:

My: My cat is sleeping on the couch.

Your: Your phone is ringing; you should answer it.

His: His car is parked in the garage.

Her: Her friends are coming over for dinner tonight.

Its: Its eyes are a beautiful shade of green.

Our: Our house is located near the park.

Their: Their dog is very friendly with strangers.

Your: Your sister is really good at playing the guitar.

● Interrogative adjectives:

What: What time is the meeting?

Which: Which color do you prefer, blue or green?

Whose: Whose car is parked in the driveway?

What: What kind of food do you like?

Which: Which book did you borrow from the library?

● Indefinite adjectives:

Some: Some people like to eat spicy food, while others prefer mild flavors.

Any: Any child can participate in the school's after-school program.

Several: Several guests arrived late to the party.

Each: Each student was given a different assignment to work on.

Every: Every person deserves to be treated with kindness and respect.

● Distributive adjectives:

Each: Each of us got food.

Every: Every customer was happy.

Either: Either phone is a good option.

Neither: Neither of the two boys were hurt.

Both: Both the boys passed the exam.

is - The car is fast.

are - The cars are fast.

am - I am fast.

was - The car was fast.

were - The cars were fast.

can be - He can be happy.

could be - We could be happy.

will be - We will be happy.

Would be - She would be happy.

shall be - They shall be happy.

should be - You should be happy.

may be - Rashed may be happy.

might be - I might be happy.

must be - I must be happy.

has been - He has been happy.

have been - We have been happy.

had been - He had been happy.

Five Sense Linking Verbs:

Feel - He feels happy. This feels good.

Look - He looks good. I look sad. She looks beautiful.

Smell - This smells good. The food smells fragrant.

Sound - This sounds bad. This sounds good. The music sounds great.

Taste - This tastes good. This tastes bad.
