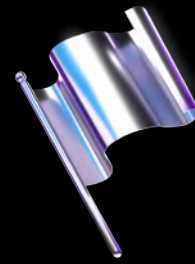

when

while

- While I was waiting for the bus, I saw a friend.
- She was reading a book while she was waiting for her doctor's appointment.
- The children played outside while their parents were cooking dinner.
